

Visitation Guidance During Coronavirus-19 Pandemic

For Staff, Elder's and Deacons

Our First Presbyterian Church shut-ins, older adults, and people with severe underlying medical conditions are at higher risk for developing complications from Covid-19 illness. Because of these issues, it is important that we practice the following safety rules during visitations beginning in Phase 2.

- 1. Wash your hands frequently.
 - Use soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
 - Or use hand sanitizer containing at least 60% alcohol.
- 2. Use social distancing
 - Stay at least 6 feet (about 2 arms length) from other people.
- 3. Wear a cloth face mask
 - Make sure it covers your mouth and nose.
 - The mask is meant to protect others in case you are infected.
- 4. Bringing food has parameters.
 - Food must be commercially made and wrapped.
 - Your presence and prayers are the best gifts!
- 5. Giving private communion needs to wait until Session gives approval.
